The Willy Aspinall Prize for an Outstanding Paper in Applied Volcanology






Given to the lead author of an outstanding paper on applied volcanology published in English within 3 years of the lead author being awarded a PhD at a university in the UK.

Eligibility


UK/Ireland based registered postgraduate students; postdoctoral researchers; or university lecturers.

Preference given to:

- research related to the Paleogene North Atlantic Large Igneous Province;
- members of one of VMSG parent societies, the *Mineralogical Society* or *Geological Society of London*; and
- researchers with limited field work funds.

The award must be spent on research fieldwork.


